Definitions and Local Rules

1a) OUT OF BOUNDS (Rule 18)

- a) In or beyond ditches, fences, hedges, walls and white stakes bounding the course on the 3rd, 4th, 7th, 8th, 9th, 10th, 12th, 17th and 18th Holes.
- Beyond the white stakes behind the 3rd, 9th, 17th and 18th greens.
 A ball coming to rest adjacent to 00B posts or boundary fence must be played as it lies
- 2 **PENALTY ZONES** (Rule17) Penalty Areas are areas of water or other areas bounded by red stakes. Relief may be taken under penalty of one shot in accordance with Rule 17.1d.
- 3 STONES IN BUNKERS are movable obstructions. Rule 15.2 applies

4 IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS (Rule 16)

- Tee markers, tee mats, fixed notice boards, seats, fixed sprinkler heads and drainage covers
- b) All artificially surfaced pathways
- c) 150 yard distance markers, sighting posts
- d) All staked trees relief MUST be taken

5 GROUND UNDER REPAIR (Rule 16.1)

- a) Wheel marks made by Green keepers vehicles
- b) All areas marked by a broken white line, blue stake or GUR sign.
- c) All unrepaired course work

If your ball comes to rest in GUR – relief MUST be taken. Under this local rule, the ball may be cleaned when lifted.

6 DISTANCE MEASURING DEVICES (Rule 4-3) that measure distance ONLY are allowed.

HEALTH AND SAFETY – TO ENSURE YOUR ROUND IS AS SAFE AND ENJOYABLE AS POSSIBLE PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING

7 SUSPENSION OF PLAY DUE TO A DANGEROUS SITUATION SUCH AS LIGHTNING (Rule 5.7a applies)

Play must be suspended if a Klaxon is sounded; otherwise players and staff are expected to take responsibility for their own safety and leave the course.

- Take care when retrieving golf balls from water hazards, banks can be steep and may cause you to slip into the hazard. Flotation rings are situated by deep water areas
- Beware of rabbit and fox holes
- Beware of low branches and brambles when entering wooded or bushy areas
- Watch out for varying slopes on tees and greens particularly in wet and windy conditions
- Beware of other golfers and of golf balls from following players
- Shout FORE if your ball looks as if it may be heading towards other players
- Take care when driving buggies and keep to the paths wherever possible.
 Do not take buggies onto the slopes. Read instructions displayed on the buggy windscreen
